After her admission to the Bar, Ms. Moss became aware that less than 1% of lawyers reported having a disability. To help revolutionize the practice of law, she founded her own company to lead the charge of working with businesses and law firms to hire and retain autistic and neurodiverse talent.

Ms. Moss is the author of "Middle School: The Stuff Nobody Tells You About" and "A Freshman Survival Guide for College Students with Autism Spectrum Disorders: The Stuff Nobody Tells You About." Her writing about autism, neurodiversity, and disability has appeared in *The Washington Post*, *ABA Journal*, *HuffPost* and *FastCompany* and she has been featured in major media including *TODAY*, *Forbes*, *CNN*, *USA Today*, *Yahoo!*, and *People*.
